

FY2023 Rolling Grant Funds List as of 2/24/2023 Application Period 11/1/22-5/1/23

Applications for support will be accepted and reviewed as they are received for as long as funding is available.

Each fund listed below is designated for specific purposes with the amount available noted. Minimum grant size is \$500. **Grants must provide direct benefits to Frederick County, Maryland, residents unless otherwise noted.**

The Impact Cycle supports two possible impacts:

P means that a fund is available to support projects.

IN means that a fund is available to support identified households or individuals.

The applicant organization must be:

- An already existing nonprofit, 501c3 organization in good standing with the IRS,
- An existing government/quasi-governmental agency applying for an extraordinary project that is not funded by tax revenue,
- A religious organization requesting funding for non-sectarian activities, or
- A civic group that is not a 501c3 organization requesting funding for a community cause.

The list of available grants and their respective criteria are as follows:

• Holly Hale Palmer Memorial Fund:

\$28.801.34 (P. IN)

Founded by mother Elizabeth K. Hale to support behavioral health services for persons with seizure or bipolar disorders, with special emphasis on acquiring, training, and caring for service dogs for persons with seizure or bipolar disorders.

• John C. Summers Fund:

\$3,148.73 (P, IN)

Founded through Mr. Summers' trust to support individuals residing in Myersville, Maryland, who are experiencing difficulty in paying their utility bills or their real property taxes.

Parks Field of Interest Fund:

\$862.24 (P)

Founded by the Community Foundation to support public park enhancements.

Platoon 22 Charitable Fund:

\$20,000.00 (P, IN)

Founded by Platoon 22, Inc to support programs serving veterans of any branch of the United States Military. Programs must provide support for entrepreneurship opportunities and/or the alleviation of extreme hardship or obstacles to better well-being. Fund has a preference for entrepreneurship programs.

• Robert Ryals Memorial Endowment Fund:

\$1,429.98 (P)

Founded by Gloria Jean Ryals to support research, treatment, and/or care impacting persons with severe mental illness. Preference given but not limited to programs addressing schizophrenia.

• The Stephen LeRoux Endowment Fund:

\$1,000.00 (P, IN)

Founded by Emily N. Seifarth to support nonprofit organizations helping people in underserved or vulnerable populations with legal expenses, legal representation, or advocacy. Preference shall be given but not limited to non-profit organizations associated with greatest human needs in Frederick County, as determined by the most recent human needs assessment.
