



## FY2024 Impact Grant Funds List as of 8/24/2023

Application Period 8/15/23-9/15/23

Each fund listed below is designated for specific purposes with the amount available noted. Minimum grant size is \$500. **Grants must provide direct benefits to Frederick County, Maryland, residents unless otherwise noted.**

The Impact Cycle supports two possible impacts:

P means that a fund is available to support projects.

IN means that a fund is available to support identified households or individuals.

The applicant organization must be:

- An already existing nonprofit, 501c3 organization in good standing with the IRS,
- An existing government/quasi-governmental agency applying for an extraordinary project that is not funded by tax revenue,
- A religious organization requesting funding for non-sectarian activities, or
- A civic group that is not a 501c3 organization requesting funding for a community cause.

The list of available grants and their respective criteria are as follows:

- **Addie B. Null Health Care Fund:** **\$2,570.17 (P)**

Founded by Ms. Null to support health and wellness programs. Preference given but not limited to Way Station, Inc.

- **AG-C.I.T.E. Fund:** **\$1,660.58 (P)**

Founded by Kaitlyn, Ashley, David, and Katherine Fuss with Robert and Susie Fogle to heighten awareness, promote agriculture, and provide agriculture educational activities for all ages.

- **Alice Jean Stine Fund:** **\$500.00 (P)**

Founded by Ms. Stine to benefit cats and feline welfare programs.

- **Alvin F. Tesmer and John J. Hayes Veterans Memorial Fund:** **\$1,000.00 (P)**

Founded by John J. and Kay L. Hayes to support services impacting the greatest needs of veterans and their immediate family including caregivers, spouses, and children in Frederick County and Carroll County with preference for services addressing basic human needs, behavioral health, or direct medical care.

- **Animal Care Field of Interest Fund:** **\$1,363.93 (P)**  
 Founded by the Community Foundation to support all areas of animal care, including pet care, agricultural animal help, and wildlife support and rescue.
- **Bar Association of Frederick County Justice for All Fund:** **\$20,000.00 (P)**  
 Founded by the Bar Association to ensure availability of competent legal representation for residents regardless of their ability to pay. Grants may pay for services related to providing free or reduced-fee legal services, including attorney fees, lawyer referral services, translator services, and interpreters for those who are hard of hearing or do not understand English. Grants may not support criminal justice activities because of the government's affirmative obligation to provide a defense of indigent defendants or class action litigation.
- **Brunswick Area Fund:** **\$2,585.92 (P)**  
 Founded by the Honorable and Mrs. William Wenner to enhance the quality of life for the residents of Brunswick, Maryland.
- **Charles V. and Louise D. Main Endowment Fund:** **\$9,857.40 (P)**  
 Founded through Mr. Main's bequest to support community charitable activities, with a preference for projects at Calvary United Methodist Church in Frederick.
- **Compofelice Family Fund for Building Trades:** **\$7,007.80 (P, IN)**  
 Founded by Susan C. Compofelice to help residents receive training for construction trades in the Frederick County area. Preference given to plumbing, carpentry, electrical services, masonry, and other skills associated with the building industry. Grants may pay for training, educational materials, certification fees, transportation costs, and eliminating any barrier that prevents students from completing their training program and establishing a career in the building trades.
- **Dan Crozier Music Trust Fund:** **\$4,750.00 (P)**  
 Founded with proceeds from the Dan Crozier Music Trust to support music appreciation, grants to musical organizations, concerts, and music scholarships for sheet music, instruments and other necessary supplies and materials, and to underwrite the costs of presenting and expanding the number of band and musical concerts.
- **Don Doughty and Linda Moran Urban Garden Fund:** **\$1,000.00 (P)**  
 Founded by Linda Moran to support urban gardening in the City of Frederick and surrounding towns. Programs/projects can include developing new or improving existing gardens in an urban setting, and/or creating or enhancing public green spaces in an urban setting.
- **Don't Just Stand There, DO SOMETHING Fund:** **\$1,603.05 (P)**  
 Founded by Gwen Romack and Evan Somerstein to support programs addressing youth homelessness or homeless families with children. Preference given but not limited to Student Homelessness Initiative Partnership, Inc. (SHIP).
- **Dr. George and Carolyn Smith Fund:** **\$570.85 (P)**  
 Founded by the Smiths to support the performing and visual arts, with preference given to offering art classes, art exhibits, concerts to be enjoyed by the general public, music instruction for underserved populations, community theater productions, and other activities that enhance Frederick County's status as an arts destination.

- **Dr. Larry J. Warner Fund:** **\$1,000.00 (P)**  
 Founded by Natalie R. Warner to support education programs for non-traditional learners, with a preference for programs offered through Allied Health Academy at Frederick Community College. Special consideration for programs assisting English-language learners, providing financial literacy, or helping people break the cycle of poverty.
- **Earlene H. and Henry J. Sr. Thornton Fund for Education:** **\$500.00 (P)**  
 Founded by Earlene Hairston Thornton to support special projects with an education focus that enhance the learning ability of students. Special consideration will be given to projects or programs benefitting students attending Middletown High School or its feeder schools.
- **Easels in Frederick Fund:** **\$4,536.67 (P)**  
 Founded by Easels in Frederick to support art programs, with preference given to youth programs or plein air art.
- **Edgar and Geraldine Virts Memorial Fund:** **\$3,165.29 (P, IN)**  
 Founded by Edgar Virts to support nonprofits serving persons with Alzheimer's disease and related disorders, people with disabilities and/or the provision of direct patient care to persons experiencing catastrophic health issues.
- **Educational Enrichment Field of Interest Fund:** **\$883.80 (P)**  
 Founded by the Community Foundation to support opportunities for kindergarten through twelfth graders to experience afterschool or special programs, lessons, camps, field trips or study-abroad programs.
- **England Family Fund:** **\$729.48 (P)**  
 Founded by Marlene England with her 2006 Wertheimer Fellow for Excellence in Volunteerism award to support programs that serve women and children in need.
- **Enhancing Agriculture Field of Interest Fund:** **\$715.17 (P)**  
 Founded by the Community Foundation to support agriculture education and the promotion of agriculture.
- **Environmental Preservation Field of Interest Fund:** **\$742.25 (P)**  
 Founded by the Community Foundation to support ecology initiatives and/or programs that protect the environment.
- **Feline Welfare Fund:** **\$1,798.76 (P)**  
 Founded by Robert and Carolyn Moroney to support initiatives that foster the welfare of the feline population.
- **Florence Zahler Memorial Cancer Support Fund:** **\$9,939.77 (P, IN)**  
 Founded by Nelson S. and Celia E. Zahler to support residents who have been diagnosed with cancer.
- **Frederick Keys Care Fund:** **\$12,261.66 (P)**  
 Founded by the Frederick Keys in memory of Joel A. Stephens to support programs serving children, youth, or young adults up to 22 years of age coping with illness, personal loss and/or disabilities.

- **Good Neighbor Fund for Seniors:** **\$6,573.08 (P, IN)**  
 Found by Donald C. Linton to provide support for individuals 60 years of age or older with financial need caused by catastrophic circumstances, such as life-threatening illness, medical conditions that hamper activities of living, loss of financial livelihood, or death of an immediate family member.
- **Grove Foundation Fund:** **\$2,500.00 (P)**  
 Founded by Larry and Deborah Grove to address the greatest needs of military veterans and soldiers throughout Maryland. Grants may be used for but are not limited to providing housing, behavioral health services, recreation and socialization, job training, medical support and complimentary therapies and services to enhance and sustain the family unit.
- **Historic Preservation Field of Interest Fund:** **\$655.53 (P)**  
 Founded by the Community Foundation to preserve the past, including historic landmarks, structures, and artifacts, for future generations to enjoy.
- **Holly Hale Palmer Memorial Fund:** **\$40,000.00 (P, IN)**  
 Founded by mother Elizabeth K. Hale to support behavioral health services for persons with seizure or bipolar disorders, with special emphasis on acquiring, training, and caring for service dogs for persons with seizure or bipolar disorders.
- **Human Services Field of Interest Fund:** **\$734.26 (P, IN)**  
 Founded by the Community Foundation to aid individuals in mental, financial, physical need or to nonprofits serving them.
- **Job Training and Skills Development Field of Interest Fund:** **\$1,518.05 (P)**  
 Founded by the Community Foundation to support quality workforce development.
- **John and Annabelle Eyler Fund for Persons with Disabilities:** **\$1,107.26 (P, IN)**  
 Founded by Anabelle Eyler's estate to support programs that serve persons with developmental, intellectual, and/or physical disabilities.
- **John C. Summers Fund:** **\$3,158.96 (P, IN)**  
 Founded through Mr. Summers' trust to support individuals residing in Myersville, Maryland, who are experiencing difficulty in paying their utility bills or their real property taxes.
- **John L. and Lucille H. Ponton Charitable Fund:** **\$95,567.65 (P, IN)**  
 Founded through Mrs. Ponton's estate to provide funds for families of children with cancer and to support Camp Jamie.
- **Kevin R. and Sara J. Wade Special Needs Fund:** **\$53,022.98 (P, IN)**  
 Founded by the Wades' estate to benefit families of children experiencing a catastrophic medical condition.
- **Lewis I. and Catherine L. Clark Memorial Fund:** **\$6,569.27 (P, IN)**  
 Founded through Mrs. Clark's charitable remainder unitrust to support programs that assist individuals with cardiac issues, cancer, or diabetes.

- **Libby Hough Van Winkle Foster Children's Fund:** **\$1,792.62 (P, IN)**  
 Founded by parents Hammet and Jaralyn Hough to meet the special or unique needs of children that are not being met through normal channels. Grants could include but are not limited to support for children's medical expenses or educational needs. Preference given to serving children in foster care.
- **Major Dan Campbell Veteran Services Fund:** **\$760.57 (P)**  
 Founded by Dan Campbell with his 2017 Wertheimer Fellow for Excellence in Volunteerism award to support services for veterans, with preference for mentoring and peer support programs.
- **Malamet Family Fund:** **\$4,000.00 (P)**  
 Founded by Raymond and Susan Malamet to support services to residents experiencing substance use disorder, including programs for education, prevention and treatment.
- **Martha Murphy Virts Memorial Fund:** **\$3,711.72 (P, IN)**  
 Founded by Edgar C. Virts, Jr. to support programs serving people with Alzheimer's disease and related disorders, assisting people with disabilities, or providing direct care to people experiencing catastrophic health issues.
- **Mary Gregg Cornish Memorial Fund:** **\$3,121.05 (P)**  
 Founded by husband Dr. Edwin R. Cornish, Jr. to support master gardener activities, gardening education, community gardens, beautification of public spaces, and library collections related to gardening. Educational activities can include but are not limited to promoting gardening and the nutritional value of using local produce or encouraging youth to become involved with gardening.
- **Mildred B. Trevvett Music Education Fund:** **\$1,012.38 (P, IN)**  
 Founded by niece Jane Clark Peluso to support the training of music educators, including but not limited to grants to support master classes, to pay master class fees and/or related training expenses for music educators.
- **Nonprofit Support Field of Interest Fund:** **\$561.03 (P)**  
 Founded by the Community Foundation to support nonprofit infrastructure and capacity building.
- **Parks Field of Interest Fund:** **\$821.92 (P)**  
 Founded by the Community Foundation to support public park enhancements.
- **Paul L. Stine, Jr. Memorial Fund:** **\$500.00 (P)**  
 Founded by sister Alice Jean Stine to support persons with intellectual disabilities or programs benefitting animals.
- **Paul L. Stine, Sr. Memorial Fund:** **\$500.00 (P)**  
 Founded by daughter Alice Jean Stine to support promoting agriculture as a career, using agriculture or farming as learning tools for youth, saving of animals such as dogs, horses, and cats from being destroyed after their productive lives are over, or providing educational opportunities for youth involved in agriculture.

- **Performing Arts Field of Interest Fund:** **\$717.91 (P, IN)**  
 Founded by the Community Foundation to support the performing arts, including dance, musical, theatrical, and live performances produced by nonprofit organizations, and individual lessons for students studying the performing arts at any level.
- **Persons with Disabilities Field of Interest Fund:** **\$1,091.40 (P, IN)**  
 Founded by the Community Foundation to assist persons with developmental, intellectual, and/or physical disabilities.
- **Pritchett Family Foundation Fund:** **\$2,000.00 (P)**  
 Founded by Jerry and Molly Pritchett to support programs for children with physical disabilities and/or children with financial need.
- **Recreation Field of Interest Fund:** **\$624.44 (P)**  
 Founded by the Community Foundation to support play areas, sporting events, festivals, and teams/leagues.
- **Refugee Support Fund:** **\$750.00 (P, IN)**  
 Founded by Covenant Capital, LLC to support nonprofit organizations in Washington, D.C., Maryland, Virginia region with a preference for Frederick County, Maryland, area providing services for refugee programs for people who have been forced to flee their country because of persecution, natural disaster, war or violence.
- **Remsberg Family Fund:** **\$3,319.02 (P)**  
 Founded by Adrian McCardell Remsberg, Jr. and Lisa Nelson Remsberg to support health care, including mental and behavioral health services.
- **Rhema H. Fogle Memorial Endowment Fund:** **\$6,551.58 (P)**  
 Founded through Ms. Fogle's bequest to provide financial support for emergency assistance to needy people who have suffered from fires, floods and other like catastrophes.
- **Robert and Carol Sharpe Fund:** **\$553.68 (P)**  
 Founded by the Sharpes to support welfare programs for domestic animals, including animal shelter and rescue efforts.
- **Robert L. De Lauter Youth Mentoring:** **\$1,000.00 (P)**  
 Founded by Robert L. De Lauter to support youth mentoring programs. Preference given but not limited to the Frederick County Explorer Post 1218.
- **Robert Ryals Memorial Endowment Fund:** **\$1,434.62 (P)**  
 Founded by Gloria Jean Ryals to support research, treatment, and/or care impacting persons with severe mental illness. Preference given but not limited to programs addressing schizophrenia.
- **Roger Brooke Taney House Endowment Fund:** **\$6,800.51 (P)**  
 Founded by Helen Delaplaine to support the preservation of the memory of Roger Brooke Taney's life in Frederick County or the preservation of other local buildings of historical significance.

- **Rosebud Frederick Senior Support Fund:** **\$1,645.29 (P)**  
 Founded by Rose Marie Willard Myers to enable senior citizens to live healthier lives and to age in place, including programs providing for basic human needs, therapeutic needs, socialization, recreation, nutrition, or adaptations to their physical environments. Preference shall be given but not limited to programs provided by the Frederick Senior Center.
- **Secret Santa Fund:** **\$ 1,470.09 (P, IN)**  
 Founded by Donald C. Linton to provide grants to residents who have special situations in which a small grant would make a difference
- **Sharon I. Hooper Fund for Children:** **\$16,869.48 (P, IN)**  
 Founded by parents Mr. and Mrs. U. Mehrl Hooper to support programs serving youth, with preference given to services for families with children experiencing catastrophic illnesses, which may include paying for medical care, providing respite care for caregivers, offering babysitters for siblings while parents are involved with the ill child's treatment, providing mental health services, and giving recreational opportunities to families to relieve stress and to divert constant attention from the child's illness.
- **Stephen LeRoux Memorial Fund:** **\$1,000.00 (P, IN)**  
 Founded by Emily N. Seifarth to support nonprofit organizations helping people in underserved or vulnerable populations with legal expenses, legal representation, or advocacy. Preference shall be given but not limited to non-profits addressing the greatest human needs, as determined by the most recent human needs assessment.
- **Transportation Field of Interest Fund:** **\$1,061.68 (P)**  
 Founded by the Community Foundation to support transportation concerns, with particular focus on those with disabilities, the elderly, or low-income households.
- **Visual Arts Field of Interest Fund:** **\$760.38 (P, IN)**  
 Founded by the Community Foundation to support all areas of the visual arts, including painting, sculpture, photography, and architecture, by awarding grants to nonprofits and scholarships to individuals pursuing training in the visual arts.
- **William and Hettie Ballweber Fund:** **\$3,046.18 (P)**  
 Founded by wife Hettie Ballweber to support canine advocacy, rescue, and proactive welfare initiatives. Not intended to support animal shelters or the care of animals within shelters.
- **William E. Barnhart Memorial Fund:** **\$34,106.36 (P, IN)**  
 Founded through Mr. Barnhart's estate to provide direct services to residents with cancer.
- **William O. Lee, Jr. and Family Endowment Fund:** **\$671.29 (P)**  
 Founded by Mr. Lee with his 2003 Wertheimer Fellow for Excellence in Volunteerism award to support programs researching, restoring, archiving, cataloging, and educating the community in areas pertaining to local African American history.
